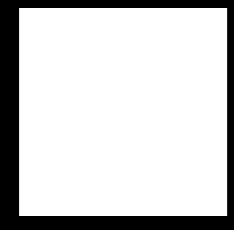

ASMR: Autonomous Sensory Meridian Response  
*"...a static-like or tingling sensation on the skin  
that typically begins on the scalp and moves down  
the back of the neck and upper spine... commonly  
triggered by soft voices, personal attention,  
ambient sounds or watching people work quietly..."*

Do you experience ASMR? We Letter String  
Quartet members do. We get it from hair brushing,  
warm breezes, typing on a keyboard, watching a  
bank teller, whisper videos, the Russian ASMR  
soap princess...

We have explored the quiet and silent  
communications that take place between  
members of a string quartet when rehearsing and  
performing as a starting point for our journey  
into ASMR triggers. We invite you inside the ritual,  
etiquette and micro relationships of the string  
quartet - a short, intimate performance of quiet  
sounds and gently triggering music.

Relax, there is no audience interaction.

We have been presenting concert series of  
new music for strings and voices for the past five  
years. We collaborate closely with composers,  
musicians, film-makers and singers to push the  
sonic possibilities of string quartet repertoire and  
present heightened, theatrical performances.
