
This book is written by Arts House.

• music




• digital art

access and inclusion advisory team.




Our access and inclusion advisory team are a group of people with disability who

What we will do




We have 5 goals.

For example, we will have better




entrances

• parking.




We will work with transport groups and people with disability to make public transport more accessible.

- update information about access on our website




• listen to ideas from people with disability

We will train our staff to


- know about access and inclusion
